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In this paper, we describe the formatting guidelines for Evolving Horizon Journal Submission.

ABSTRACT

In abstract you have to incorporate **i) four things:** Purpose, Methodology, Findings and Originality/Value and **ii) Keywords**

Keywords are your own designated keywords which can be used for easy location of the manuscript using any search engines.

1. INTRODUCTION

We ask that authors follow some simple guidelines. In essence, we ask you to make your paper look exactly like this document. The easiest way to do this is simply to download the template, and replace the content with your own material.

2. PAGE SIZE

All material on each page should fit within a A4 size, centered on the page, beginning 2.54 cm (1") from the top of the page and ending with 2.54 cm (1") from the bottom. The right and left margins should also be 2.54 cm (1").

TYPESET TEXT

2.1 Normal or Body Text

Please use a 10-point Cambria (Headings) font, or other as close as possible in appearance to Cambria (Headings) in which these guidelines have been set. The goal is to have a 10-point text, as you see here. Please use sans-serif or non-proportional fonts only for special purposes, such as distinguishing source code text. Right margins should be justified, not ragged.

Please use a 12 point Cambria (Headings) font, or other as close as possible in appearance to Cambria (Headings) in which these guidelines have been set. The goal is to have a 12-point text, as you see here. Please use sans-serif or non-proportional fonts only for special purposes, such as distinguishing source code text. Right margins should be justified, not ragged.

Please use a 12-point Cambria (Headings) font, or other as close as possible in appearance to Cambria

(Headings) in which these guidelines have been set. The goal is to have a 10-point text, as you see here.

Title and Authors

The title (Cambria, 16 pt bold), authors' names (Cambria 12-point, bold) and affiliations (Cambria 9-point) run across the full width of the page – one column wide. We also recommend e-mail address (Cambria 10-point, italic). See the top of this page for three addresses. If only one address is needed, center all address text. For two addresses, use two centered tabs, and so on. For three authors, you may have to improvise.

2.4 Subsequent Pages

For pages other than the first page, start at the top of the page, and continue in one column wide format.

2.5 Page Numbering, Headers and Footers

Do not include headers, footers or page numbers in your submission. These may be added when the publications are assembled.

3. FIGURES/CAPTIONS

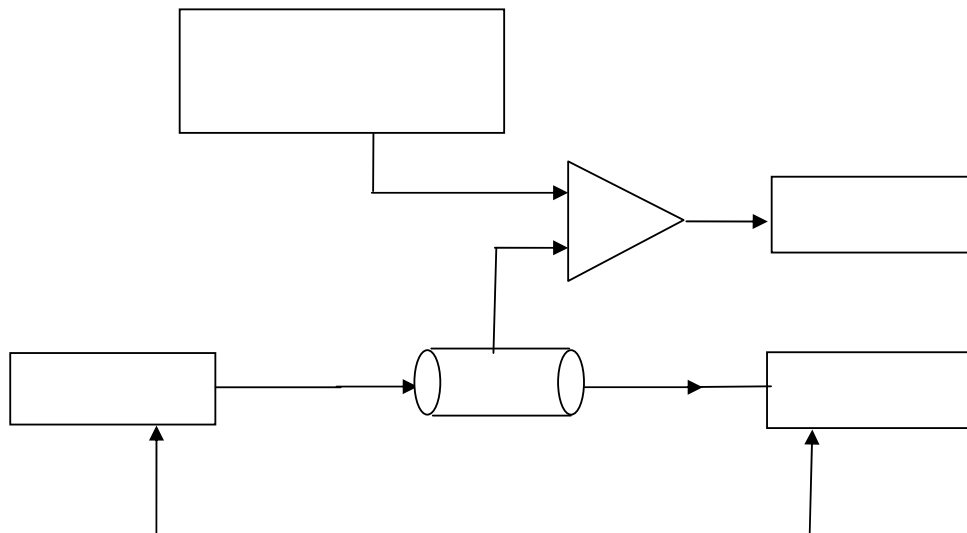


Fig 1: If necessary, the images can be extended both columns

Place Tables/Figures/Images in text as close to the reference as possible (see Figure 1). It may extend to a maximum width of 17.78 cm (7").

Captions should be Cambria 12-point bold. They should be numbered (e.g., "Table 1" or "Figure 2"), please note that the word for Table and Figure are spelled out. Figure's captions should be centered beneath the image or picture, and Table captions should be centered above the table body.

4. SECTIONS

The heading of a section should be in Cambria 12-point bold in all-caps flush left with an additional 6-point of white space above the section head. Sections and subsequent subsections should be numbered and flush left. For a section head and a subsection head together (such as Section 3), use no additional space above the subsection head.

4.1 Subsections

The heading of subsections should be in Cambria 12-point bold with only the initial letters capitalized. (Note: For subsections and subsubsections, a word like *the* or *a* is not capitalized unless it is the first word of the header.

4.1.1 Subsubsections

The heading for subsubsections should be in Cambria 11-point italic with initial letters capitalized and 6-points of white space above the sub-subsection head.

4.1.1.1 Subsubsections

The heading for subsubsections should be in Cambria 11-point italic with initial letters capitalized.

4.1.1.2 Subsubsections

The heading for subsubsections should be in Cambria 11-point italic with initial letters capitalized.
