ADMISSION BROCHURE FOR B.ED/M.ED (2025-27)

Applications are hereby invited from eligible candidates for admission in B.Ed./M.Ed. programmes for the academic session 2025-27 in Satyapriya Roy College of Education. All the applicants must read the following instructions carefully and abide by the rules of admission given below fully before proceeding to apply.

Once the application form is filled up and submitted, a unique Application Number will be generated automatically. Applicant should have to note and preserve the Application No. carefully.

ADMISSION INFORMATION:2025-27:

FOR B.ED:

- 1. Successful submission of application form online, for admission to 2 years B.Ed. Course for the session 2025-27 in this college does not automatically ensure her/his eligibility for admission to the course.
- 2. NO REGISTRATION FEE will be charged for filling up the online form. Once the Application No is generated, **applicant** will get the print out of the filled-in Application Form.
- This system will remain open for online form submission from 2nd September 2025 to 11th September, 2025 till 11.59 pm.
- 4. Applicant should keep two copies of E-Receipt(Applicant & College copy) safely. College copy will be required at the time of scrutiny.
- 5. Applicants are advised to provide a valid mobile number so that college may communicate whenever required. Applicants are requested to visit the applicant panel frequently for getting admission related notices, information, payment status etc.
- 6. The Merit list will be published on 13.09.2025. Admission will be starting from 13.09.2025 to 16.09.2025 and the second list will be published against vacant seats, if required, on 17.09.2025.
- 7. The admission for Second listed candidates against the vacant seats, if any will be starting from 17.09.2025 to 19.09.2025. The subsequent merit lists, against vacant seats if required, will be published on and from 22.09.2025.
- 8. Eligibility Criteria: Candidates (both Fresh & Deputed) with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Science/Social Science/ Humanities or Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks, or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for application. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in favour of SC, ST and PWD (Persons with disabilities) categories.

N.B: 50% or 45% marks (as the case may be for GEN/SC/ST/OBC) in Bachelor's degree with Hons. may be determined either based on Hons. marks only or based on Hons. marks and marks of the elective subjects taken together.

- 9. The Merit list for the fresher candidates will be prepared in each school subject (given in item no. 11) based on academic and extra- curricular scoring and for deputed candidates Merit list will be prepared for school subjects as given below based on length of his/her service.
- 10. Deputed candidates must submit filled in duly generated format for certification by their employer and government authority duly signed and *copies of Approval for the Post held* at present and earlier along with the *Resolution of the Managing Committee* of the School concerned(present employer)along with a certificate from the school, countersigned by DI of Schools (SE) concerned, certifying that they teach classes IX onwards in the school. Teachers working in the Govt.-aided (Govt. of West Bengal) institutions only, will be considered under Deputed category. Their candidature will only be treated valid after the format is duly countersigned by the D.I. of Schools (SE)/ competent authority concerned.
- 11. The school subjects offered for admission are: Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Life Science, Physical Science, Education, History, Geography, and Political Science. The applicant must have one of these school subjects in the graduation level as main subject.
- 12. The deputed candidates are required to produce "No Objection Certificate" from their employers allowing them to pursue the course of studies on full-time basis and candidates pursuing any other Course of Studies/Part-time or Full-time Job/Full-time Research Work and the like will not be allowed to pursue the Course simultaneously.
- 13. Verification of all original documents will be made at the time of the commencement of the session 2025-27. If any short-listed candidate fails to produce any of his/her original documents, her/his candidature will be automatically cancelled and the next candidate would be given the opportunity for admission.

14. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- ❖ For Deputed candidates, short-listing will be done based on approved Teaching Experience and total score obtained from academic score.
- For Fresher candidates of all categories(Gen, SC,OBC-A&B, ST,PWD), short list will be made based on the following criteria.
 - i. 10% of the percentage of obtained marks in Madhyamik/equivalent examination.
 - ii. 20% of the percentage of obtained marks in Higher Secondary/equivalent examination.
 - iii. 20% of percentage of obtained in B.A/B.Sc. General Degree examination.
 - iv. 30% of marks obtained in B.A/B.Sc.(Hons) examination (% of marks obtained in this case must be computed considering the marks of Hons. Subject only).
 - v. 35% of marks obtained in M.A/M.Sc. examinations.
 - vi. 3 score points for candidate possessing valid M.Phil degree.
 - vii. 5 score points for candidate possessing valid Ph. D degree (Candidate having both M.Phil and PhD degrees can demand for only either of these two degrees)
 - viii. Aggregate of above, calculated for a candidate would constitute the Total Score Point.

- 19. The entrance test and verification of all the applicants will be held on 15.09.2025 at 11:30 AM at the college premises. The Merit list(According to Merit score and Entrance Test score) will be published on 15th September, 2025.
- The admission will be start from 15.09.2025 to 17.09.2025 and the second list will be published against vacant seat, if any, on 19.09.2025.
- 21. The admission for Second listed candidates against the vacant seats, if any will be from 19.09.2025 to 21.09.2025 (till 5pm.) The subsequent merit lists will be published thereafter against the vacant seats, if required on and from 22.09.2025.

- 24. Eligibility Criteria: Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed course should possess at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in the following courses:

B.Ed/ B.El.Ed /D.El.Ed (with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each). Relaxation of 5% in the qualifying marks will be allowed in graduation or post graduation or B.Ed in case of SC,ST, PWD(Minimum disability 40%) candidates.

25. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- i. For Deputed candidates, short-list will be made based on approved Teaching Experience and total score obtained in the admission test.
- ii. For Fresher candidates of all categories (Gen, SC, OBC-A & B,ST, PWD), shortlist will be made based on counting 50% score from their academic records and 50% of the score obtained in the Admission Test to be held on 15.09.2025 at 11:30 am.
- iii. 10% of the percentage of obtained marks in Madhyamik/equivalent examination.
- iv. 20% of the percentage of obtained marks in Higher Secondary/equivalent examinations.
- v. 20% of percentage of obtained in B.A/B.Sc. General Degree examination.

- vi. 30% of marks obtained in B.A/B.Sc. (Hons) examination (% of marks obtained in this case must be computed considering the marks of Hons. Subject only.
- vii. 35% of marks obtained in M.A/M.Sc examinations.
- viii. 3 score points for candidate possessing valid M.Phil degree.
- ix. **5 score points** for candidate possessing valid Ph. D degree (Candidate having both M.Phil and Ph.D degrees can claim score for only one choice)
- x. 35% of marks obtained in B.Ed examination(4th semester students not receiving final mark sheet will count total marks up-to third semester Examinations)
- xi. Aggregate of all the above, calculated for a candidate would constitute the Total Score Point.
- 26. The deputed candidates are required to produce "No Objection Certificate" from their employers allowing them to pursue the course of studies on full-time basis and candidates pursuing any other Course of Studies/ Part-time or Full-time Job/Full-time Research Work and the like will not be allowed to pursue the Course simultaneously.
- 27. Intake capacity: 50 (The ratio of Home University and Other University Students is 80:20).
